If a conference delegate cannot for any reason be present at the conference to vote in any election (hereafter referred to as "the absentee"), the absentee may by notice in writing signed by the absentee and delivered to the Returning Officer before nominations close at the conference on 18 May 2026, appoint another delegate to exercise the absentee's right to vote in the election.
